The possible risks associated with this study are any typical discomfort one might feel when they play a video game on a computer screen.

The possible benefits to your child's participation in this study are increasing their knowledge about the environmental and historical significance of specific areas in the Lehigh River watershed.

No information that can identify your child personally, such as their name, will be collected. Other researchers could request the non-identifiable data after our study concludes.

Your decision whether or not to participate is voluntary. You are free to withdraw your child from this study at any time. Your child may skip any question that they are not comfortable answering.
